It has been such an encouraging year with God being so kind to help us keep trying to reach others for Jesus. We have been able to have several events on campus to engage with students; one girl shared "Hey I am not going to go to your thing, but my friend is really wanting to connect; when do you guys do things?" We loved that she felt comfortable to just say she is not interested and we were not going to judge or condemn her. And we know if her friend engages with God more and community more (and we hope that means going to church with our students) - we know she will be around her friend. So we are praying for her and just the influence that could bring to her

Our Korean students are engaging with not just our community, but also other Koreans. It is so exciting seeing them starting a small group that is in Korean with their Bible study and singing together. Beautiful! A girl we have known for 2 1/2 years because of her friend that knew a girl (Ziwei from China who after 4 years gave her life to Jesus) started coming to our worship nights and then small group has moved closer to God after growing up Catholic. A few weeks ago she called for help moving back into a dorm because she didn't feel safe at her apartment. I was at the dentist and Stacey was home with the kids, but after a few crazy quick messages we had 3 trucks and a couple of cars and 10 students to help her move. After the move, we all went out to eat and met her parents. She is now attending our small group. One of our girls recently shared that her classmate, who is not really religious said if she was she would definitely come and be a part of the BSU because you guys do so much to take care of our campus.

Wow God, she may not be able to put her finger on it, but God is working in her. We are so grateful for everyone and all their prayers and support because God is hearing them! -Greg and Stacey


